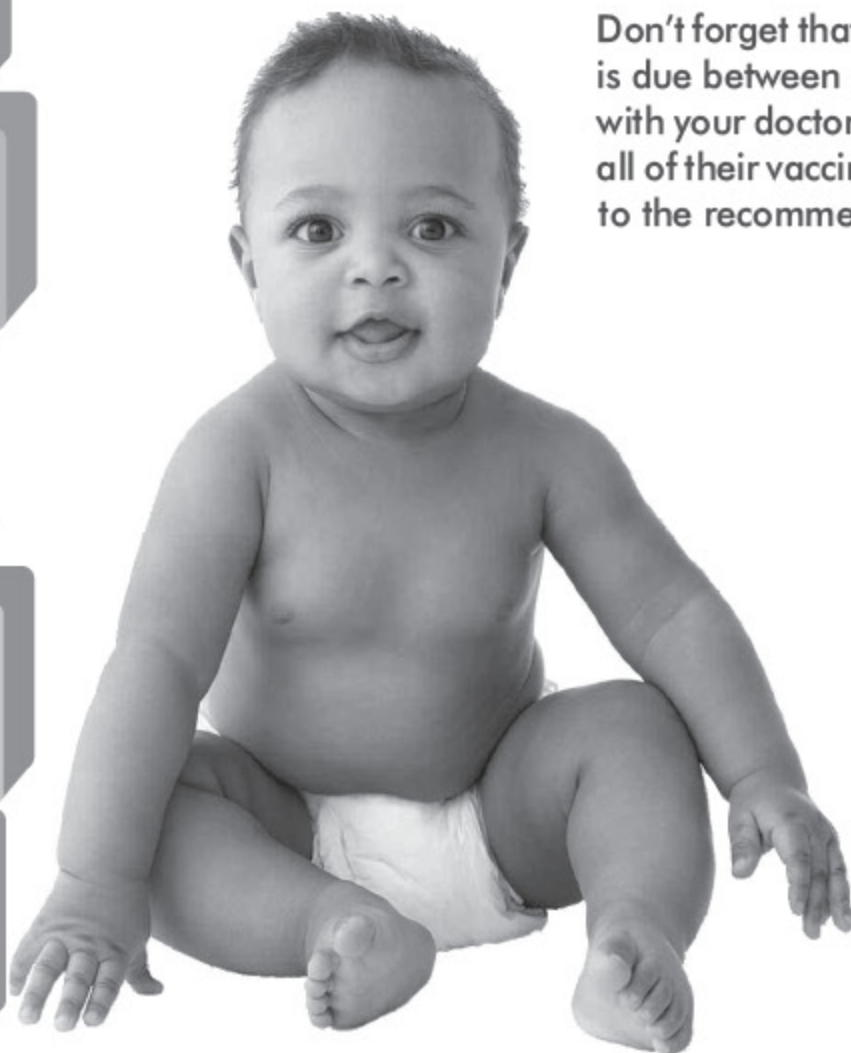


# Every Vaccine Counts
